CAPELLA, -THE BRIGHTEST STAR OF AURIGA THE CHARIOTEER, CASTOR AND POLLUX, -THE HEADS OF GEMINI, PROCYON -THE BRIGHTEST STAR IN CANIS MINOR AND SIRIUS, -THE NOSE OF ORION'S HUNTING DOG, CANIS MAJOR.
