DEAN:

THE PERSEID METEOR SHOWER WILL BE AT ITS BEST ON THE
12TH AND 13TH,

BUT IT COULD BE GOOD

A DAY BEFORE OR AFTER. TO SEE THE MOST METEORS,
GET AWAY FROM

CITY LIGHTS, LIE BACK, AND BE PATIENT. CONTINUALLY SCAN THE SKIES WITH
YOUR NAKED EYE AND YOU MAY SEE

A DOZEN OR TWO PER HOUR.
